**REPORT ON THE CITIZEN FORUM BY THE KEHANCHA
MUNICIPAL BOARD ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A HEAVY
COMMERCIAL VEHICLE AT KEHANCHA AND MUNICIPAL
INTEGRATED DEVELOPMENT PLAN PRESENTATION**

INTRODUCTION

On May 28, 2024, the Kehancha Municipal Board held a citizen forum at the plot previously leased by the Municipal Council to Master Mind, located directly opposite the Kehancha Level Four Hospital. The forum aimed to gather community input and achieve consensus on the establishment of a heavy commercial park in Kehancha. The meeting commenced at 9:49 a.m. with a prayer led by Apostle John Ketungo.

OPENING PROCEEDINGS

After the opening prayer, participants introduced themselves, starting with the leaders and technical officers accompanying the Municipal Manager, Mr. Nokwi Maroa. Mr. Maroa officially opened the meeting, acknowledging the leaders present and emphasizing the significance of the heavy commercial park project for the town's development. He outlined the forum's agenda and invited various speakers to give opening remarks.

SPEECHES FROM THE LEADERSHIP

Several leaders addressed the forum to set the tone for the discussions.

1. Hon. Bageni, Member of County Assembly and Chairman of the Committee on Implementation at the County Assembly of Migori, highlighted the necessity to decongest the Central Business District (CBD) by constructing a heavy commercial park.
2. Mr. Jomo, Market Chairman, expressed the market traders' perspective, supporting the need for a designated heavy commercial park.

3. Mr. Moses Muhindi, chairperson of the lorry drivers Association, underscored the logistical challenges and the importance of an organized parking space for lorries and buses.

4. Mr. Benson Mwaura, Assistant County Commissioner, representing the Deputy County Commissioner, along with other Sub-County Heads, reinforced the administrative support for the project.

5. Mr. Willys Bolo, the Needs Assessment Consultant, applauded the participants for their reasoned decision-making. He pointed out that any development plan must balance societal interests with economic and environmental needs.

PROJECT BACKGROUND AND PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Mr. Gitiba, a Board Member, provided an in-depth explanation of the project's basis and the importance of public participation. He stressed that the community's input was crucial for ensuring the project's success and alignment with public needs.

COMPLIANCE WITH MUNICIPAL PLANS

The Municipal Planner, Mr. Ezekiel, sensitized participants on the need to adhere to existing municipal plans, particularly land use plans for the proposed locations. He emphasized the importance of selecting a site that aligns with these plans to ensure sustainable urban development.

The public participation forum was a crucial step in the process of establishing a heavy commercial park in Kehancha, allowing the community to voice their concerns and contribute to the decision-making process.

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RESOLUTION

The forum unanimously agreed that the heavy commercial park project was to be established at the Emirates site, next to the Office of the Member of the County Assembly (MCA) for Bukira East Ward.

The decision to locate the heavy commercial park at the Emirates site was reached after carefully considering the concerns raised by the participants, including the proximity of the plot initially proposed site to the mortuary, noise pollution to the nearby hospital and school, logistical challenges, such as inconvenient access to refueling stations.

The forum considered the importance of adhering to the existing municipal plans and land use regulations to ensure sustainable urban development. According to the Kehancha Physical development Plan, Emirate site had been set aside for commercial purpose.

The forum commended the efforts of the Kehancha Municipal Board in facilitating the public participation process and incorporating the community's input into the decision-making.

The members pledged their full support and commitment to the successful implementation of the heavy commercial park project at the Emirates site.

The participants finally mandated Kehancha Municipal Board to proceed with the necessary steps to actualize the establishment of the heavy commercial park at the Emirates site.

Public Feedback on the Kehancha Municipal Integrated Development Plan

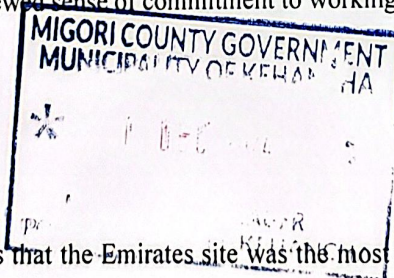
During a recent presentation, members of the public were given an in-depth look at the priorities laid out in the Kehancha Municipal Integrated Development Plan (IDeP). The municipality shared the key challenges it's currently facing and outlined the strategies being put in place to address them. The community appreciated the municipality's proactive approach in identifying these issues and felt encouraged by the detailed projects included in the plan to tackle them head-on.

Many expressed their support for the proposed initiatives and recognized the importance of the community's active involvement in making the plan a success. There was also a strong acknowledgment of the need for ongoing engagement and feedback from the public to ensure the plan continues to evolve and meet the needs of the community. By the end of the session, both the municipality and the public shared a renewed sense of commitment to working together to achieve the goals of the Integrated Plan.

CONCLUSION

The meeting concluded with a consensus that the Emirates site was the most suitable location for the heavy commercial.

The meeting concluded at 11.51 a.m. with prayers from Pastor Onyango (Happy Church).
