Highlights from the Kehancha Municipal Board Meeting

The Kehancha Municipal Board held a productive meeting to address critical municipal matters. Below are the key highlights:

1. Development of Bi-Laws

- The board resolved to draft bi-laws to strengthen municipal governance. The draft will be prepared with expert assistance and submitted to the County Assembly of Migori for approval.

2. Protection of Municipal Properties

- A visit to the Land and Environment Court Judge is planned to address illegal mining on municipal land. A court order will be sought to halt these activities.
- The board will review the status of squatters and schedule a site visit for optimal use of acquired land in Burure Ginonos.
- Plans are underway to clear and fence the Kurutiyanje dumping site once funds are available.
- Municipal land parcels, including those for Maranatha ECDE College, the church near the municipality office, and other public spaces, will undergo further follow-up for proper management.

3. Infrastructure Maintenance

- The board proposed creating a parking lot for heavy vehicles opposite the Deputy County Commissioners residence to ease congestion in the Kehancha CBD.

4. Budget for the Fiscal Year 2024/2025

- The recurrent expenditure ceiling was set at **KES 21,000,000**, and the development expenditure ceiling at **KES 10,000**.
- Kehancha Municipality is slated to receive **KES 16,800,000** through the Kenya Urban Support Programme II, contingent upon meeting set conditions and performance standards.
- Funds will support municipal operations, administration, infrastructure development, and employee compensation.

5. Re-Allocation of Bus Park Kiosks

- The kiosks at the bus park will be re-advertised for allocation in January 2025 after the current tenants complete their rental obligations for 2024.

Conclusion

The meeting concluded at 5:54 PM after extensive deliberations on municipal improvements. The board reaffirmed its commitment to enhancing Kehancha Municipality's development and management.
