**CITIZEN FORA REPORT FOR KEHANCHA MUNICIPALITY ON THE KENYA
INFORMAL SETTLEMENTS IMPROVEMENT PROJECT (KISIP)
KEHANCHA CHINI INFORMAL SETTLEMENT**

1. Introduction

Kehancha Municipality organized a Citizen Fora meeting aimed at sensitizing residents of Kancha Chini Informal Settlement on the implementation of the Kenya Informal Settlements Improvement Project (KISIP). The programme is an initiative of the Government of Kenya designed to improve the living conditions of residents in informal settlements through infrastructure development, enhanced land tenure security, and improved urban planning.

The meeting was held at the Kehancha Municipal Office grounds and was attended by municipal officials, local leaders, and residents of Kancha Chini Informal Settlement.

2. Purpose of the Citizen Fora

The Citizen Fora was convened to:

- Sensitize residents about the objectives and components of the Kenya Informal Settlements Improvement Project.
- Inform residents about the planned infrastructure and development interventions within Kancha Chini Informal Settlement.
- Provide a platform for residents to express their views, concerns, and expectations regarding the project.
- Promote transparency, accountability, and community participation in municipal development programmes.

3. Meeting Proceedings

The forum began with introductions where residents present introduced themselves and indicated the specific areas within Kancha Chini where they reside. Municipal officials and other leaders also introduced themselves to the participants.

The Chairperson of Kehancha Municipality, Mr. Samson Matiko Bohoko, welcomed the residents and thanked them for attending the meeting. In his remarks, he explained the importance of the Kenya Informal Settlements Improvement Project and emphasized that the programme is expected to greatly improve the living conditions of residents in informal settlements.

He informed the residents that the programme will focus on improving infrastructure within the settlement. Some of the proposed interventions include:

- Opening and improvement of access roads
- Installation of security lighting
- Provision of water and other essential social services

He further urged residents to support the programme and cooperate with government officials to ensure its successful implementation.

4. Public Views and Contributions

During the plenary session, residents were given an opportunity to share their views and concerns. The following issues were raised:

- A resident requested that the project coverage area be expanded so that more households within the settlement can benefit from the programme.
- Another resident emphasized the importance of transparency in the implementation of the project.
- Members of the public also expressed appreciation to the municipality and the county government for planning development projects within their area.

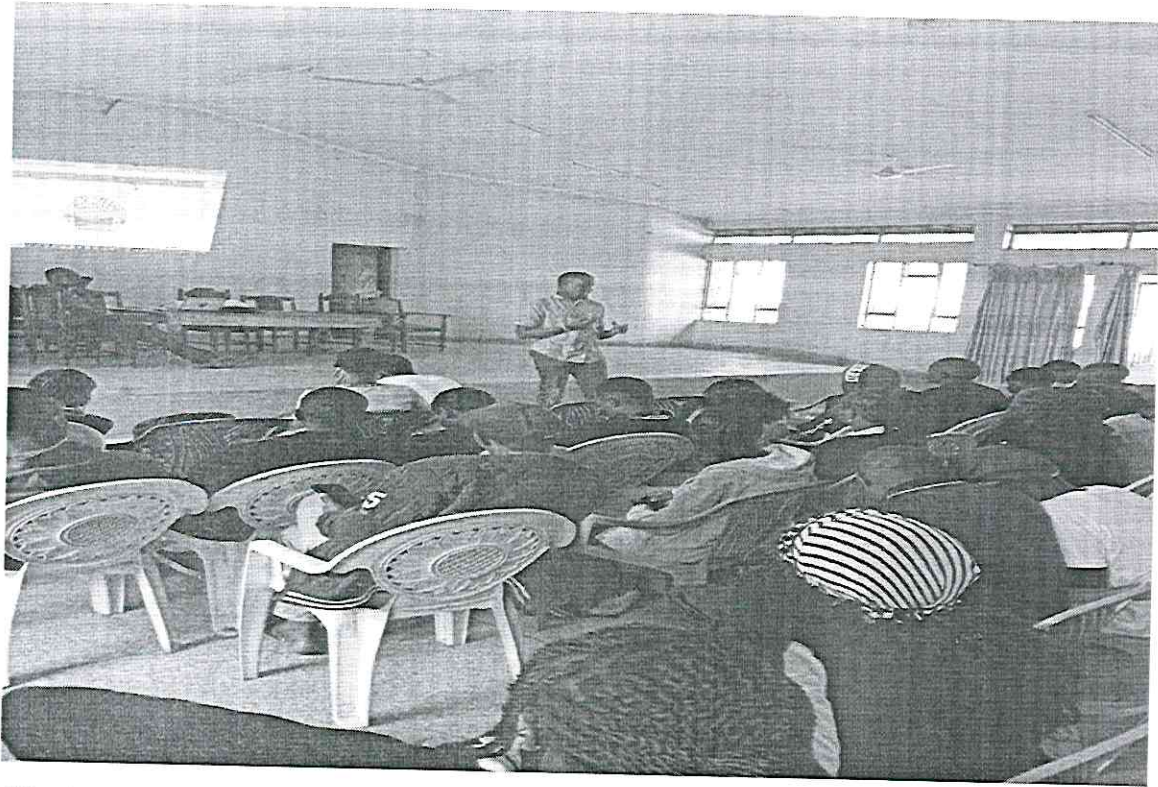
5. Remarks from Leaders

The Ward Administrator also spoke during the forum and encouraged residents to cooperate with the municipality and the county government to facilitate smooth implementation of the project.

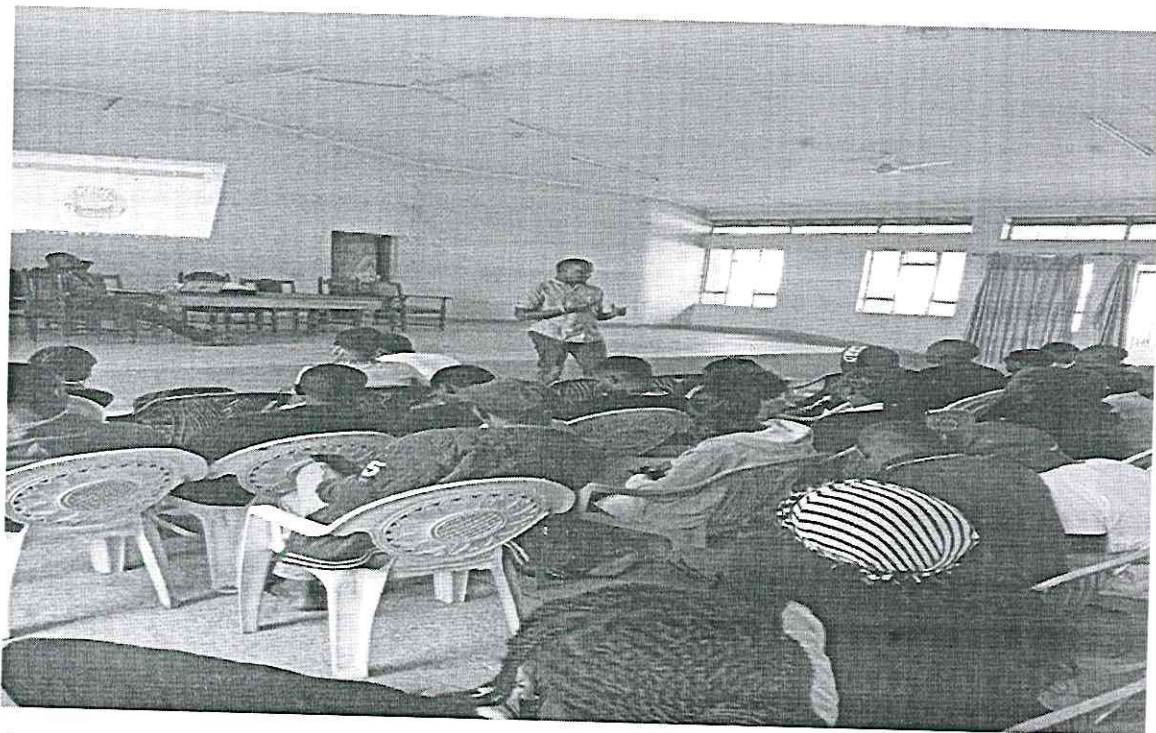

7. Conclusion

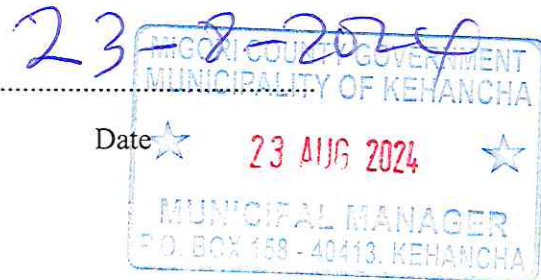
