CITIZEN FORA REPORT FOR KEHANCHA MUNICIPALITY ON PUBLIC PARTICIPATION FOR THE MIGORI COUNTY ECONOMIC EMPOWERMENT PROGRAMME- KEHANCHA MUNICIPALITY

1. Introduction

Kehancha Municipality hosted a public participation meeting to sensitize residents about the Migori County Economic Empowerment Programme. The programme is an initiative by the County Government aimed at enhancing the quality of life for residents by strengthening local economic activities and supporting small businesses.

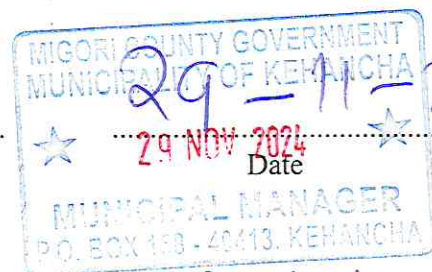
