MIN. No 2 FBM/23/10/2024: Preliminaries

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 A.M. with a word of prayer from Hon. Johnson Omolo Owiro. The Chairperson welcomed all members and staff present and emphasized the importance of strengthening economic infrastructure and environmental sustainability within the Municipality.

MIN. No. 2 FBM/23/10/2024: Consideration of Municipal Market Infrastructure Improvement Program

The Municipal Manager presented a report on the status of municipal markets and trading spaces within Awendo Municipality.

The report highlighted that markets play a critical role in supporting local economic development and providing livelihood opportunities for residents.

Members were informed that some municipal markets currently face challenges including:

- Inadequate market stalls and trading spaces
- Poor sanitation facilities
- Limited drainage infrastructure
- Congestion in existing market areas

The Municipal Manager further noted that the Municipality intends to undertake market improvement initiatives, including:

- Construction of additional modern market stalls
- Rehabilitation of existing market infrastructure
- Improvement of sanitation and drainage facilities
- Provision of waste management services within markets

Members deliberated extensively and emphasized that well-developed markets are essential for supporting small-scale traders, enhancing local revenue generation, and improving the urban environment.

Board Resolutions

The Board resolved that:

1. Management develops a Municipal Market Infrastructure Improvement Plan.
2. Priority be given to markets with high congestion and inadequate sanitation facilities.
3. Stakeholder consultations be conducted with traders prior to implementation of improvement programs.
4. The Municipality explores partnerships with development partners and the private sector in improving market infrastructure.

MIN. No 3 FBM/23/10/2024: Review of Environmental Conservation and Climate Resilience Initiatives

The Municipal Environment Officer presented a report on environmental conservation Initiatives within the Municipality.

The presentation highlighted several ongoing initiatives including:

- Tree planting programs within urban spaces
- Public awareness campaigns on environmental protection
- Waste management Improvement initiatives
- Promotion of sustainable environmental practices

Members acknowledged the importance of integrating climate resilience measures in municipal planning and development activities.

The Board emphasized that environmental conservation should be considered a cross-cutting priority in all municipal development programs. It was then resolved that:

1. Environmental conservation initiatives be integrated into all municipal development planning processes.
2. Management strengthens tree planting programs and environmental awareness campaigns.
3. The Municipality collaborates with community groups, schools, and development partners to promote environmental conservation.


