KEHANCHA MUNICIPALITY PUBLIC HIGHLIGHTS THIRD BOARD MEETING HELD ON 13TH MARCH 2025

The Kehancha Municipal Board held its third Sitting on 13th March 2025 at the Municipal Boardroom to deliberate on key development and operational matters affecting the municipality. Below are the key highlights for public information:

1. Urban Institutional Grant (UIG) – KES 4 million Allocation

The Board approved an expenditure plan for KES 4,000,000 allocated to Kehancha Municipality under the Urban Institutional Grant. The funds will support:

Serial No.	Activity	Objective
1	Training and Capacity Building	To equip board members and municipal staff with relevant knowledge and skills to enhance service delivery and urban governance.
2	Purchase of ICT Equipment	To strengthen digital infrastructure, improve communication, data management, and enhance operational efficiency
3	Preparation of Kehancha Municipality By-Laws	To establish a legal and institutional framework for effective governance and compliance with urban regulations
4	Furnishing of the Municipal Manager's Office	To provide a functional and professional working environment that supports effective administration and leadership

These investments are aimed at improving efficiency, accountability, and institutional capacity within the municipality.

2. Budget Outlook for FY 2025/2026

The Board reviewed and discussed the proposed budget ceilings:

- Recurrent expenditure: KES 15,330,201

- Development expenditure: KES 6,500,000

Recurrent funds will cater for operations, board activities, administration and employee compensation while development funds will focus on infrastructure improvements within the municipality.

3. Kenya Urban Support Programme II (KUSP II)

Kehancha Municipality had been identified as a beneficiary of the Kenya Urban Support Programme II, subject to meeting required conditions and performance standards.

- An estimated KES 16.8 million is expected to renovate Kehancha Fresh Produce Market in the upcoming financial year.


4. Commitment to Service Delivery


